



CAMPING, MOTORHOMES AT RAND FESTIVAL

- The camping pitches are not allocated. The camping paddock is a vast space where you'll be able to pitch your tent up where you please.
- Pitch Sizes are not strictly limited, however, please be considerate of your neighbours and only take the space you require.
- The motorhome pitch is situated in a separate paddock to our tent campers. Pitch sizes are not allocated due to the varying nature of sizes on motorhomes and caravans.
- The price includes an empty pitch allocation and access to our toilets and showers.
- Festival tickets are not necessarily included in your ticket. Please check your selection before purchasing.
- Camping includes free parking in a dedicated car park which is situated next to the car park. For the safety of our festival goers and campers, you are not permitted to park next to your pitch or bring your vehicle onto the camping paddock under any circumstances
 - We can not reserve spaces. If you would like to pitch next to a friend or family member, then you will need to arrive together
 - No dogs are permitted on the Festival or Camping paddocks.
 - EHU/Electrics are not available and you are responsible for your own waste
 - You can arrive from 9:00am - 12:00pm on the day of your booking start and must leave by 10:00am on the last day of your purchased ticket
 - There will be a selection of food and drink vendors throughout the duration of your stay.
 - There will be running water taps too which will be signposted.
 - Toilets and showers are available throughout your stay.
 - No generators are permitted due to their noise
 - No open flames, BBQs, fires, and or fire pits are permitted.
 - Gas camping stoves are permitted
 - Festivalgoers are not permitted to bring alcohol into the main arena
 - No glass is permitted on site.
 - By purchasing tickets for Rand Festival 2026, you agree to comply with any reasonable requests required by the local authority and or government to ensure the festival can go ahead.
 - You are welcome to bring a picnic with you. Food and drink within the festival paddock will also be available for you to purchase.
 - We will be operating bag searches for the Festival Paddock so please be patient and have your bag open ready to be searched when you enter the Festival Paddock
 - When you head into the Festival Paddock, please note that you do not bring alcohol, glass, fluids, or liquids with you. (Alcohol will be confiscated at the entrance points)
 - You may bring food and drink into the campsite for his/her/kids own consumption, provided. Food and drink will be available to purchase from within the Festival Paddock. Excessive amounts of food, drink, alcohol, or cigarettes may be confiscated.
 - Rand Farm Park operates a zero-tolerance on underage drinking. No one under 18 is permitted to bring alcohol to or be under the influence of alcohol at, the event. If you are unable to produce ID evidencing that you are 18 years old or over when challenged your alcohol will be confiscated and you risk being refused entry into the event or arrangements may be made for you to leave
 - A challenge 25 policy will be in operation on all bars.
